### **Valeo Pride Outpatient Program (VIOP)**

The Valeo Pride Intensive Outpatient Program is a specialty program designed to treat gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender adults. The program treats those with a psychiatric or dual diagnosis, which may include both behavioral disorders and chemical addictions. Patients may transition from Chicago Lakeshore Hospital Valeo inpatient program or be referred from traditional outpatient treatment from one of our community partners.

### **Discharge Planning:**

Discharge planning is an integral part of effective treatment. Aftercare plans may include family and/or individual therapy, medication monitoring, self-help and support groups, Intensive Outpatient Programs, Partial Hospital Program and assistance with safe housing. Because our program is about a holistic approach to overall health and wellness, we also connect with existing or re-connect with a Primary Care Physician
